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### **ACTION REQUESTED**

Approve Proposed Revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 0420, School Plans/Site Councils

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Board Policy is being updated to reflect a NEW LAW (AB 716) which renames the Single Plan for Student Achievement as the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA), and authorizes the use of the SPSA to satisfy the requirement for a school improvement plan when a school is identified for targeted or comprehensive support.

Any complaints alleging noncompliance with requirements related to the establishment of school site councils or the development of the SPSA may be filed with the district in accordance with the district's uniform complaint procedures.

The regulation is being updated to reflect AB 716 which eliminates the authority to use a school advisory committee other than a school site council to develop the SPSA. It does allow for certain small schools to share a school site council; this would require a needs assessment to identify school goals and may require consultation with the school's English learner advisory committee.
