Information Only – First Read of Proposed Revisions to Board Policy and Exhibit 5145.6 Parental Notifications

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Board Policy is being updated to reflect that whenever a student enrolls in a district school during the school year, his/her parent/guardian shall be given all required parental notifications at that time. These notifications are to be presented in an understandable and uniform format, and in a language that parents/guardians can understand. Should fifteen (15) percent or more of the students enrolled in a district school speak a single primary language other than English, all notices sent to the parent/guardian of any such student shall, in addition to being written in English, also written in the primary language, and may be responded to either in English or the primary language.

The Exhibit is being updated to reflect notices required by a NEW LAW, including notices related to students' right to a free public education regardless of immigration status or religious beliefs (AB 699).

District staff conducted a thorough process of ensuring that all required notifications are presented to parents. Notices that were required but not included in the Annual Parent Notification packet provided by PCOE are now included in the TTUSD Addendum.
