SUBJECT: Accept Liberty Utilities Rebate

ACTION REQUESTED:

Accept Liberty Utilities rebate in the amount of \$1,830.68

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Electric utility companies serving California schools offer rebates for the installation of energy-saving projects or programs. The California Energy Commission regulates the rebates by funds collected from consumers.

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District has previously received multiple rebates from Liberty Utilities through their rebate program. As part of the Kings Beach Elementary School Modernization project, the district completed several lighting upgrades, which included the replacement of fluorescent fixtures with LED fixtures and the replacement of the lighting controls.

The district can expect to see a 15,000-kWh reduction annually, which will equate to approximately \$2,500.00 in annual savings. The expected lifespan of the new lighting fixtures and controls is approximately 20 years.
