**BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

The Western Association of Schools and Colleges (ACS WASC) accreditation process is an ongoing six-year cycle of quality whereby the school demonstrates the capacity, commitment, and competence to support high-quality student learning and ongoing school improvement. Schools are expected to participate in self-study training provided by ACS WASC throughout the 18 months prior to the full self-study visit. For the past 18 months, North Tahoe High School has been assessing its programs and its impact on student learning with respect to the ACS WASC criteria/indicators and other accreditation factors. This self-study process has now culminated. The results and schoolwide action plan are being presented tonight.
