SUBJECT: Accept Truckee Donner Public Utility District (TDPUD) Rebate

ACTION REQUESTED:

Accept Truckee Donner Public Utility District (TDPUD) Rebate in the amount of \$98,631.78

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Electric utility companies serving California schools offer rebates for the installation of energy-saving projects or programs. The California Energy Commission regulates the rebates by funds collected from consumers.

The Tahoe Truckee Unified School District has previously received multiple rebates from the Tahoe Donner Public Utility District (TDPUD) through their rebate program. As part of the Truckee Elementary School and Truckee High School Modernization projects, the district completed several energy conservation projects which included the replacement of fluorescent fixtures with LED fixtures, the replacement of the lighting controls, and a circulation pump replacement.

At Truckee Elementary School, this rebate will reimburse the Measure-U project funds by \$90,000.00 for lighting replacements and new controls installations completed throughout the existing classrooms and the new library. The district can expect to see approximately \$6,000.00 in annual savings. The expected lifespan of the new lighting fixtures and controls is approximately 20 years.

At Truckee High School, this rebate will reimburse the Measure-U funds by \$8,631.78 for the circulation pump replacement. The district can expect to see approximately \$1,500.00 in annual savings. The expected lifespan of the new circulation pump is approximately 20 years.

RESOURCES REQUIRED: This rebate will reimburse the Measure-U funds with \$98,631.78.
