Approve Proposed Revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 4113 Assignment

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Policy updated to reflect NEW LAW (AB 1219, 2019) which requires annual monitoring of the assignment of certificated employees at all schools, and requires the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) to administer a statewide system that produces an annual data file of vacancies and misassignments and provides districts an opportunity to submit additional evidence that an employee is legally authorized for the assignment. Policy also adds legal requirements to report misassignments in the school accountability report card and to use Williams uniform complaint procedures to address any complaint alleging teacher misassignment or vacancy. Regulation updated to make minor corrections for gender neutrality. Regulation has been provided as information only.

Proposed revisions to Board Policy were presented to the Board for review as recommended by the model provided by CSBA on July 8, 2020 and are being brought back to the Board for approval. Administrative Regulation is provided as information only.
