Approve Proposed Revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Regulation 3515 Campus Security

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Policy updated to clarify that audio capability of surveillance equipment should be disabled in accordance with state law prohibiting the recording of conversations unless the parties to the conversation may reasonably expect that the communication may be overheard or recorded, and to reflect a National Institute of Justice recommendation that signage state that the district's surveillance system may or may not be actively monitored. Regulation adds section on "Locks" reflecting requirement for state-funded new construction projects, as well as certain modernization projects, to include locks that allow classroom doors to be locked from the inside. Regulation also adds strategies to increase adult presence and supervision on campus and to provide staff training in emergency response. Administrative Regulation is provided for information only. This policy was presented to the Board on May 6, 2020 and is being brought back for approval.
